In 1849 the Andriske family first established vineyards in Southern Victoria. Over half a century later in 1911 they were drawn to the rich sandy soils of the Murray Darling region of Mildura. After six generations the Andriske family still proudly tend their vineyards in the same region.

Mulcra Estate Reserve wines are traditionally made from handpicked fruit, whole bunch pressed and patiently matured in French Oak barrels.

This wine exhibits a deep crimson/brick color. The aroma shows ripe fruit with good barrel aged complexity, leading to a robust and mouth filling palate with a firm tannin structure. It will certainly benefit from bottle aging for those who are patient enough to allow it!
