In 1849 the Andriske family first established vineyards in Southern Victoria. Over half a century later in 1911 they were drawn to the rich sandy soils of the Murray Darling region of Mildura. After six generations the Andriske family still proudly tend their vineyards in the same region.

Mulcra Estate Reserve wines are traditionally made from handpicked fruit, whole bunch pressed and patiently matured in French Oak barrels.

The resulting wine shows a beautiful deep, rich color akin to the juice of ripe blood plums mixed with that of blueberries. The aroma shows an abundance of sweet berry fruits combined with subtle French Oak. The palate is mouth filling with lots of soft, fruit flavours, gentle tannin, with a long satisfying finish.
