LATE HARVEST

The Mulcra property was first planted with vineyards by Henry Andriske and his brother Harold in 1933. They were drawn to the rich sandy soils of the Murray Darling region of Mildura. After six generations the Andriske family still proudly tend their vineyards in the same region.

Mulcra Estate Reserve wines are traditionally made from handpicked fruit, whole bunch pressed and patiently matured in French Oak barrels.

The resulting wine shows a deep rich purple/plum color with a rich aroma of spicy berry fruit, vanilla oak and barrel aged complexity. The palate is full bodied, with nicely integrated oak. There is a good backbone of fine, grained tannin which will ensure its cellaring potential.
